4. Let one of the officers know about ideas you have concerning programs or other avenues of interest which the Section should pursue.



It is our full intention to keep all members better informed on ASQC plans and activities throughout this season. It is possible that you may be interested in some of the following items.

1. As of 30 June 70, total ASQC membership was 24,397, an increase of 5.7% from last year.
2. As of 30 June 70, the Las Vegas Section had a total of 32 members, a decrease of 4 since 30 June 1969. (Help us reach our goal of 70 new members this season.)
3. A list of present Las Vegas Section members and our present mailing list is enclosed.
4. The recommended Code of Ethics for ASQC was approved by the Board of Directors in May. A copy is enclosed.
5. The ASQC Education and Training Institute (ETI), Milwaukee, has published their schedule of seminars for 1970-1971 season. A copy is enclosed.
