Certification/Recertification FAQ (frequently asked questions)

Q: *How do I become certified?*

A: There are three requirements for ASQ certification:

1. Have a specified level of education and/or experience
2. Provide proof of professionalism
3. Pass a standardized examination in the certification area. (Exams are given in the English language only.)

Q: *How do I apply for certification?*

A: The ASQ website (www.asq.org) has all the information you need.

Q: *Once I become certified, how do I check on my certification status?*

A: Go to www.asq.org, in the certification section, and you can log-in to check your certification status.

Q: *What happens if I don't pass the exam the first time?*

A: You can re-take the exam, as long as you do it within two years of your first exam. (\$\$ each re-take)

Q: *Which certifications have maintenance requirements? (re-certification)*

A: Certified Quality Manager, Certified Quality Auditor, Certified Quality Engineer, Certified Software Quality Engineer, Certified Reliability Engineer, Certified Six Sigma Black Belt, Certified Calibration Technician, and Certified HACCP Auditor.

Q: *Once I'm certified, what should I be gathering to accumulate RU's (Recertification Units)*

A: Training attendance sheets, meeting minutes, seminar agendas, etc. (relative to the BOK of your certification).

Q: *Who do I send my recertification package to?*
